

I-95 Girard Avenue Interchange Improvement Project

I-95 North On-Ramp at Girard Avenue Interchange in Philadelphia to Close December 16 for Reconstruction and Replacement

The on-ramp to Interstate 95 north at the Girard Avenue Interchange in Philadelphia will close for reconstruction and replacement on Wednesday, December 16, with on-ramp traffic being rerouted to the I-95 Interchange at Castor Avenue.

The on-ramp will close for approximately 18 months while the contractor builds new northbound on-and-off ramps as part of the ongoing reconstruction and improvement of northbound I-95 at the interchange. The northbound I-95 off-ramp at Girard Avenue will remain open during construction.

Motorists normally using the Delaware Avenue on-ramp to I-95 north will be detoured north on Richmond Street to a temporary, northbound-only detour road accessible from Richmond Street near Ann Street. Northbound motorists will follow the temporary road to Allegheny Avenue, turn right on Allegheny Avenue, turn left on Delaware Avenue, turn left on Castor Avenue, and turn left at the ramp to I-95 north at the Castor Avenue Interchange.

In addition, southbound Richmond Street will be closed and detoured between Lehigh Avenue and Delaware Avenue for 18 months beginning December 16 for the construction of a new intersection where the new northbound I-95 entrance and exit ramps will be located. Southbound Richmond Street traffic will be detoured west on Lehigh Avenue and left on Aramingo Avenue to Delaware Avenue.

I-95 Betsy Ross Bridge Interchange Improvement Project

Aramingo Avenue On-Ramp to I-95 South at Betsy Ross Bridge Interchange to Close December 21

The Aramingo Avenue on-ramp to Interstate 95 south at the Betsy Ross Bridge Interchange in Philadelphia will close for reconstruction on Monday, December 21, with on-ramp traffic being rerouted to the I-95 Interchanges at Allegheny Avenue and Girard Avenue.

The on-ramp will close for approximately nine months while the contractor rebuilds and widens the ramp as part of the ongoing project to rebuild ramps and improve connections at the I-95 Interchange with the Betsy Ross Bridge and Aramingo Avenue. This on-ramp is accessible from a larger ramp that also carries traffic from Aramingo Avenue to I-95 north. The section of the on-ramp leading to I-95 north will remain open during construction.

Detours will be posted for both passenger vehicles and trucks during the ramp closure.

Trucks normally using the Aramingo Avenue on-ramp to reach I-95 south at the Betsy Ross Bridge/Aramingo Avenue Interchange will be detoured south on Aramingo Avenue, left at Castor Avenue, right at Delaware Avenue, right at Allegheny Avenue, and then left at the on-ramp to I-95 south.

Passenger vehicles will be detoured south on Aramingo Avenue to the on-ramp to I-95 south at the Girard Avenue Interchange.
